

# Poster Project Book Report

Create a poster based on a book that you have read this marking period (during Spring Break or the month of April). The poster should resemble a movie poster. Students should use 11 x 17 poster board or paper (provided). **5 pts**

## The poster should include:

- Title of the book (underlined and correctly capitalized), **5 pts**
- Author, **5 pts**
- Publisher, **5 pts**
- Large picture or collage showing an interesting part of the book, **15 pts**
  - The poster and picture should **NOT** be based on the front cover of the book or an existing movie poster.
- Written description in 50 words or more summarizing the story, **and** why someone else might enjoy the book (must be in *your own words*), **40 pts**

**It is important that you proofread your work before you turn in the final product. Below is the rubric for your written summary. You can earn less than 40 points if you are not careful. Be sure to proofread!**

Clearly states the main idea of the story. Paraphrases with vivid descriptive language. Contains only 1-2 minor errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling, or grammar.	States the overall idea of the story. Paraphrases with descriptive language. Contains only 3-5 errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling, or grammar.	Somewhat states the overall idea of the story. Somewhat paraphrases with some descriptive language. Contains 5-9 errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling, or grammar.	Has no statement of the overall idea of the story. Uses the original language of the story or book jacket. Contains 10+ errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling, or grammar.

## Please make sure to:

- Complete planning page with draft. Turn it in with the project for **5 pts**.
- Include your name on the front of the poster. **5pts**
- Have all of the requirements mentioned above arranged on your poster in a pleasing, eye-catching fashion (design, color, and neatness count). Be ready to *present your poster* to the class. **15 pts**
